Topic

Class Dojo

Literacy

There will be a big focus on the literacy this year. All children will receive the same spellings and will be tested weekly. These will include bronze words that all must learn, silver words that will follow a particular spelling rule and gold words for a nice challenge. Year 1's will have a new set every two weeks. These will be sent home on a Friday and posted on class dojo. All children have also been given a reading diary and are expected to bring it in to school every day as part of their daily equipment. It is great to already see some positive comments from grownups in them. All children will receive at least one read from an adult per week but we endeavour to read as much as possible. Further to reading and spelling some maths challenges will be sent home weekly.
