Dear parents/carers

I have had some great feedback from the children about caring for Wilson or Tommy over half term.

Here is some basic information for caring for a Giant African Land Snail:

- change food in the evening
- favourite food is cucumber and lettuce
- wash food thoroughly and cut into chunks
- peel the cucumber
- spray tank and lid lightly once a day with water
- change water daily
- wash hands thoroughly with soap before and after handling the snail
 - monitor temperature of tank 23-27 degrees

Here is some basic information for caring for a hamster:

- feed daily
- change bedding once a week
- · change water every two to three days

To take Tommy home it is important to be aware that hamsters can bite when scared or nervous and this does hurt!
